

SIMULATION GRADING

For the first part of the simulation grade (100 total points), students will be graded based on participation based on the following scale.

POINTS EARNED

Bi-monthly speeches to the gathered United Nations:	8 @ 5 points each
Monthly world summit negotiations:	4 @ 5 points each
Publication of bi-monthly status reports:	8 @ 5 points each

Points will be accumulated by the group and each group leader will determine what percentage of the points earned will be given to each member of the group (i.e. The whole group earns 95 points out of 100, then leader determines student A deserves 90% of the points. Student A would then get an 85.5% participation grade.)

For the second part of the simulation grade (100 total points), students will be graded based on the following scale as determined by actions in the simulation. Members of each group will receive the same grade.

POINTS EARNED:

Primary goals achieved:	+50 each
Primary goals not achieved:	- 50 each
Secondary goals achieved:	+15 each
Secondary goals not achieved:	- 15 each

Points will be ranked and each group will get the following grade based on the ranking:

Country that earns most simulation points:	100%
2 nd most simulation points earned:	85
3 rd most simulation points earned:	75
4 th most simulation points earned:	70
5 th most simulation points earned:	60
6 th most simulation points earned:	55
7 th most simulation points earned:	50%
